

PURELL® and PROVON® 2% CHG Water-Aided Surgical Scrub Method

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Effective use of this product as a surgical scrub requires 5 mL per hand/arm

IF HANDS ARE VISIBLY SOILED, WASH HANDS FIRST WITH SOAP AND WATER.



STEP 1

- Remove debris from underneath fingernails using a disposable nail cleaner under running water¹



APPLICATION 1

STEP 2

- Wet hands and forearms with water
- Dispense 5 mL of product (6 actuations) into hands



STEP 3

- Apply product to the hands and forearms
- Scrub for 3 minutes
- Pay close attention to the nails, cuticles and skin between the fingers



STEP 4

- Rinse hands and forearms under running water in one direction from finger tips to elbows



APPLICATION 2

STEP 5

- Dispense a second application of 5 mL of product (6 actuations) into hands
- Apply product to hands and forearms
- Scrub for 3 minutes
- Pay close attention to the nails, cuticles and web area in between fingers



STEP 6

- Rinse thoroughly under running water in one direction from finger tips to elbows



STEP 7

- Hold hands higher than elbows and away from surgical attire
- In the OR or procedure room, dry hands and arms with a sterile towel using sterile technique before donning a surgical gown and gloves
